Eligibility

The Regatta is open to skippers and crews who are members of a member WYA yacht club in good standing as of 2017. Each competitor must complete a registration.

Fees

The Entry fee is \$ 65.00 per yacht if entry is received or postmarked by July 21th 2017, or \$ 80.00 if registration and payment is received or postmarked after July 21th. The entry fee includes lunches

for two sailors on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Additional lunches are available for \$8.00 at registration and at mealtime depending upon available food stock. The Saturday dinner will be catered, so please email peterkeck@yahoo.com by July 26th with Saturday dinner intentions. Saturday dinner tickets must be purchased by 12:30, Friday Aug 4th for \$20.00 per person.

Trophies

Perpetual trophies are awarded to the winning skippers. The top 10 skippers and crews will receive trophies. A final trophy presentation will follow the racing on Sunday.

Risks

Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The race organizers (organizing authority, race committee, protest committee, host club, sponsors, or any other organization or official) will not be responsible for damage to any boat or other property or the injury to any competitor, including death, sustained as a result or participation in this event. By participation in this event each competitor, or in the case of minors, each competitor's parent or guardian, agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitors' participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing, RRS, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the ILYA, the WYA and by the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions will be provided at check-in, or will be available online for download at the www.sailnlyc.org website. This is an invitational Category C event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

Courses

The racing area will be on the navigable waters of Nagawicka Lake. The courses to be sailed will be described in the Sailing Instructions which will be available online at: www.sailnlyc.org

Mooring

Boats will be moored along the SW shore. A buoy and anchor system will be needed to hold your boat in a sandy bottom at a depth of 6-15 ft. All competitors are responsible for securing their boats to a sufficient anchor that will hold a boat in place during heavier winds. Taxi service will be provided prior to and immediately following races. No overnight pier parking is available at the Nagawicka Lake Yacht Club.

Parking

Trailer Parking will be at the Heinze's house at the top of the hill. Follow the signs.
Car Parking will be at a premium. Each team should only bring one car to the Headquarters.
